



Parent's Evenings

We are holding Parents' Evenings this Monday 23 April from 2.00 to 5.00 and Monday 30 April from 3.00 to 5.30pm. Children will need to be collected at 1:50pm this Monday and 2.50pm on Monday 30 April.

During these meetings, we will conduct a reading fluency test with your child (1 minute for 100 words with key stage 1 children and 2 minutes for 200 words for key stage 2 children. We will share French assessment results and discuss your child's attendance and punctuality. We will review your child's tracked summit stamp achievements and their home reading habit, as well as their detention record. You will have the opportunity to ask any questions about your child's progress having received their latest data in the home learning workshop.



Finally, we will be checking GP details to ensure all pupils are registered, and we are requesting all families to provide us with up-to-date e-mail addresses so we can send this weekly newsletter and other letters to you electronically.

Please make sure you have signed up for an appointment with your child's class teacher. All parents/carers are expected to attend. Please do not send an older sibling or other family members, and most importantly make sure your child is present for this review. If your working hours make it difficult to attend, our staff are happy to arrange an alternative time. There will be a crèche available for younger children, so you and your children are able to give your full attention to these important discussions about their progress. We look forward to these special meetings with all our families.
