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Parent Survey Results

Thank you for the time our parents and carers gave to completing the annual parent survey. We received a total of 106 responses, which was 66% of the community at the time. Please turn over to see a full breakdown of your views about Ark Paddington Green. The senior leadership team have been meeting with the families that had questions or concerns they wished to raise in the survey, in order to gain further insight and address any misconceptions. We are very pleased that in all areas the vast majority of the community feels positive about the educational experience their child is receiving, with no results less than 91% in agreement. The lowest scoring item at 91.2% was regarding bullying. In response to this feedback, Katy England, the pastoral lead across KSA and APG, will be delivering training for all staff during the 5 September INSET days before school starts for pupils. Also, our home learning workshops in the Autumn term will also address this issue so that the whole community has a shared understanding of what bullying is.
