Word of the Week

Psychologists Betty Hart and Todd Risley conducted research in children's vocabulary. Their study showed that by the time children are 4 years old, children from lower-income families hear 30 million fewer words than children from higher-income families. It is referred to as the "vocabulary gap". Over the past 2 years at APG, we have been developing and learning new strategies to increase our pupils' breadth of vocabulary to support reading comprehension and improve the quality of lesson discussion. From next week, Mrs Deeks will try something new by introducing a word of the week every week during threshold, and children standing in the line before 8.20 will be expected to take part in fun daily activities to learn all about this word and practise using it in different forms and contexts.
